

"Private Truths, Public Lies" within agent-based modeling.

The title of this talks is inspired by the Timur Kuran's book entitled "Private Truths, Public Lies. The Social Consequences of Preference Falsification". During my presentation I will talk about the idea and real-life examples of Preference Falsification (PF).
